

**Are you interested in featuring your fiber in the Wool Book?** If so, we are requesting that you answer the following questions and send fiber samples in accordance with the information below:

1. What are your products (please include breeds and colors)? Where are your products milled (if applicable)? Do you have a micron count for your wool?
2. Where do people find your products?
3. If people want to create a project with your fiber, when is the best time for them to access/purchase the raw material?
4. What's the best way to get in touch with you?
5. What is your approximate annual production (in pounds)?

Your page in the Wool Book requires the following fiber contribution, which **must be received by April 15, 2016 to be included in the Spring 2016 update:**

For each type of fiber that you want to include, we are requesting:

- 2 oz. of clean fiber to create a fleece swatch on your page, and either:
- 1 skein of approx. 200 yards if you have milled yarn already, **or**
- 8 ounces clean fiber for spinning
- Optional: if you would like to include a machine felted sample on your page, please include 8 ounces of batts.

Our suggestions for selecting and sending your sample are below:

Choosing your fibers:

- Focus on what you would ideally sell, which should be based on consistent quantities.
- Submit the fiber you have the most of (i.e. if you have one sheep of a certain breed, it's not really worth a page in the book). Select your favorite breed or species that you have an abundance of.
- If you want to market a blend of fibers to designers, then a blend of several species and breeds is welcome, as long as you sent it already blended in the ratios that you want to sell.
